SUMMARY OF THE EXAM

A venous insufficiency exam uses ultrasound, gel and a probe to view and evaluate the veins in your legs. The test is done to see how well the blood is flowing in the veins of your legs. It is also used to check for varicose veins. Varicose veins can lead to poor circulation and may cause swelling, heaviness and/or dull, achy pain in the legs. Ultrasound uses no radiation, dyes or needles.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- You will be asked a brief history related to the exam.
- You will be asked to remove your pants and shoes. You will be given a gown or blanket for privacy.
- A sonographer will apply gel to the area being evaluated. The probe is moved over your skin, some pushing over your legs is required. It is important to remain relaxed during the exam.
- You may hear your blood flowing while the exam is being done.
- Once the ultrasound is complete, you may wipe off any excess gel and go home unless you have other testing scheduled.
- A doctor will interpret the exam and a report will be sent to your ordering doctor.

HOSPITAL PARKING
